



Maturity Models

Common Characteristics

Level 5 - Organizational focus - on sustained optimal performance, strategic PM planning, defect prevention, continuous improvement, value management.

Level 4 – Corporate processes - quantitative/qualitative analysis of project/program results aid identifying root causes of problems and full scope solutions for improvement.

Level 3 – Defined processes - documented processes consistently used to systematically manage projects; conscious training provided to develop/maintain PM skills

Level 2 – Results repeatable - disciplined use of established policies, informal processes include project planning, tracking, cost control and progress reporting

Level 1 - Initial stage - characterized by unpredictable, inconsistent results, with no formal procedures.
